9:10 am	Buses arrive at schools to pick up students	 Be ready rain or shine! Organize students in their groups Some adult supervisors may need to drive - there is lots of parking on site
9:30 - 11:30 am	Activity Stations	 Adult supervisors are responsible for the conduct of students in their groups at all times Visit stations in random order
11:30 am - 12:00 pm	Lunch	 Activities will be closed during lunch Please eat in the designated lunch area
12:00 - 1:25 pm	Activity Stations Resume	
1:25*	Departure	 Activity stations close at 1:25 pm Move promptly to the departure area and find your school sign

Please remember:

- Adult supervisors are responsible for the behaviour of their group at all times.
- Students must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Teachers and adult supervisors are responsible for notifying the Festival Coordinator and photographers if they have a student(s) that cannot be photographed. Please also draw a rain drop on the student's name tag.
