9:30 - 11:30 am	Activity Stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adult supervisors are responsible for the conduct of students in their groups at all times• Visit stations in random order
11:30 am – 12:00 pm	Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Activities are closed during lunch• Please eat your lunch in the lunch tent
12:00 - 1:20 pm	Activity Stations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Refer to morning Activity Stations section
1:20 - 1:30 pm	Departure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Activity stations close at 1:20 pm• Move promptly to the departure area and find your school sign. DO NOT GO DIRECTLY TO YOUR BUS

Please remember:

- Supervisors are responsible for the behaviour of their group at all times.
- Students must be **accompanied by an adult at all times.**
- Teachers and adult supervisors are responsible for notifying photographers if they have a student(s) that cannot be photographed. Please draw a raindrop on the name tags of children who cannot be photographed.
