9:30 - 11:30 am	Activity Stations	<p>Activity Stations Run</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adult supervisors are responsible for the conduct of students in their groups at all times• Start each group from a different location
11:30 am - 12:00 pm	Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Activities will be closed during lunch• Please eat your lunch in the designated lunch area
12:00 - 1:25 pm	Activity Stations	<p>Activity Stations Continue</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students continue to participate in the activity stations.
1:30 - 1:45 pm	Departure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Activity stations close at 1:25 pm• Move promptly to the departure area and find your school sign
