9:30 - 11:30 am	Activity Stations	Activity Stations Run • Adult supervisors are responsible for the conduct of students in their groups at all times • Start each group from a different location
11:30 am - 12:00 pm	Lunch	 Activities will be closed during lunch Please eat your lunch in the designated lunch area
12:00 - 1:25 pm	Activity Stations	Activity Stations Continue • Students continue to participate in the activity stations.
1:30 - 1:45 pm	Departure	 Activity stations close at 1:25 pm Move promptly to the departure area and find your school sign
